



## **All Blacks v Australia Bledisloe Cup Test: Pre and post event road closures**

### **Pre-event (from 2pm)**

- To be established when pedestrian volumes crossing Bunny Street become significant.
- Bunny St closed at Featherston Street end.
- No right turn closure Waterloo Quay, southbound into Bunny Street.
- Stout Street, no right turn into Bunny Street.
- Featherston Street left lane closure (Mulgrave Street to Whitmore Street), no left turn into Bunny Street.
- VMS trailers activated.
- STMS may open up the Bunny Street / Featherston Street closure point to allow buses to exit Bunny Street once pedestrian levels have decreased.
- No taxi's or drop offs after 2pm.
- Advisory signage to be established approaching Waterloo Quay/Cornwell Street intersection (approx. 100m prior to traffic signals).

### **Post-event (from 4.45pm)**

- Bunny Street closed at Featherston Street end.
- No right turn closure Waterloo Quay, southbound into Bunny Street.
- Stout Street, no right turn into Featherston Street and Bunny Street.
- Thorndon Quay closed (Davis Street to Mulgrave Street).
- Mulgrave Street closed (Aitken to Thorndon Quay/Featherston Street).
- Featherston Street closed (Mulgrave Street to Whitmore Street).
- To be removed when pedestrian volumes become normal/manageable.
