

Emergency preparedness instructions for a Stadium visitor, worker & patron.

At Sky Stadium we take our role as host very seriously. Your safety is our first priority. Please take some time now to study this document, inspect your surroundings and locate your nearest emergency exits.

In the event of an emergency, here's what you should do:



FIRE - Evacuate and Assemble

- If you hear a continuous fire alarm, immediately leave the building via the nearest safe exit
- Follow the instructions of Wardens, security staff and the PA system announcements
- If you discover a fire, follow the RACE method
 - R Remove people in immediate danger
 - **A** Alert others, inform a member of staff or operate a fire alarm call point
 - **C** Confine fire and smoke (close all doors and windows if safe to do so)
 - **E** Evacuate to Assembly Area (Remain at Assembly Area if safe to do so, do not re-enter the building until given the all clear by emergency personnel or the venue Emergency Team Chief)



EARTHQUAKE - Drop, Cover and Hold

- Drop to the ground, get under cover and hold on
- If you are seated in the stadium bowl, remain in your seat
- Do not evacuate (unless instructed to do so)
- Wait for the shaking to stop and then follow the instructions of Wardens, security staff and the PA announcements
- Do not enter the car park



DISABILITY

If you require assistance, please inform venue security and staff



EVACUATION

 If there is no apparent alarm and you need to evacuate, please follow instructions of Wardens and security staff

Follow the instructions of wardens and security staff at all times; they are trained in our emergency procedures.

Sky Stadium has a public address system that operates throughout all areas. This will be used to communicate in the event of an emergency. Please listen for further information.



Remember:

- Do not use the lifts
- Walk in an orderly manner at all times and remain calm
- Do not carry anything downstairs with you
- Watch for falling items or other hazards
- When instructed, assemble at the Emergency Assembly Point
- Do not return to the building until instructed to do so by emergency personnel

Useful Tips:

- Prior to arrival, arrange a safe meeting point outside the venue in case you should become separated
- On arrival, familiarise yourself with your location, your nearest exits and the best route to them, and identify security staff
- Security staff are distinguishable by their yellow flouro clothing and 'Red Badge' insignia
- Ask our friendly staff if you have any questions or concerns
